family the conventional way without success. Three miscarriages and a hysterectomy later, we pursued adoption and became parents for the first time.

Our daughter's birth mother, my friend, has shown us what true unconditional love looks like. Even though there were many challenging times, emotionally and physically, she was relentless in her decision. We honor you for your courage and your strength in considering adoption.

Justino and I have been together over 15 years and live just outside of Denver, Colorado. Our daughter Annemieke (pronounced Anna-meek) was born in the summer of 2017. We have two pets, Basil and Koa, who are fun high energy dogs who love to play. Our hobbies as a couple include spending time outdoors, movie nights, and getting together with other families. We attend church consistently and are both actively involved with our congregation.

We have a wonderful relationship with our extended family members whom all reside within the state of Colorado. We also enjoy seeing Annemieke's birth family as often as we can. Annemieke has a wonderful relationship with her birth family, and we try to see them as often as possible. She has two older brothers and an older sister whom she loves to play with.










How they met...


