






Hello! We are so grateful that you've picked up our book.

Our hearts know that this is what we're meant to do, and we can't wait to continue on the journey.


OUR STORY

About Dave By Dalla



- Whenever I travel to a new place, I always try to find the spots where the locals go.





We love going to the Italian Market




Our neighborhood has many families with young children, which means parks and plenty of daycare options.



FAMILY TRADITION


Every August Dalla's family spends a week at the beach – we've been going to the same location for more than 30 years!






While we can't know exactly what kind of parents we'll be until we are in that situation, there are a few things that we are sure of already.
